Winter Driving Tips

UNDERSTAND AND USE ABS CORRECTLY. ABS will increase your stopping distance on icy road conditions. Gently applying the brakes to the point just before the ABS is activated will reduce your stopping distance. If you feel ABS come on, press down hard on the pedal, look and steer where you want to go and don't let up on the pedal until you are out of danger.

FOLLOW AT A SAFE DISTANCE. Keep well back of the vehicle ahead of you in order to give yourself room to stop. Remember, without tire chains, it takes three to 12 times the amount of distance to stop on snow and ice as on dry concrete

REMEMBER, condensation on the pavement of bridges and over-passes freeze before the rest of the roadway. Our roads still have fallen leaves on them which may also be slippery.
